



ACT Raising Safe Kids Facilitator Training

ACT is a parenting program for parents and caregivers of children aged 8 and younger. It was developed and is directed by the American Psychological Association. Participants in the 2-day ACT workshop learn to conduct an evidence-based, nine-session parent training program designed to prevent child maltreatment, build parents' positive, nonviolent parenting skills, and mobilize communities and families to protect children from violence.

CRITERIA: Eligible professionals must *apply for the training and must have an Associates or other college degree and be currently working at an organization that serves families and/or young children.*
